NOTICE OF ELECTION OF MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, August 25, 2020, an election for the purpose of electing a mayor and a city council member for each of five (5) city council positions numbered position one, position two, position three, position four, and position five for the City of Trussville, Alabama, will be held, and that all registered and qualified electors of the state, who reside within the corporate limits of Trussville, Alabama, and have resided therein for thirty (30) days or more immediately preceding the date of the election, and who are qualified to vote in the county precinct which embraces and covers that part of the corporate limits of the City of Trussville in which the elector resides, will be authorized to participate in the election.

The polls will be opened at Trussville City Hall, 131 Main Street, at First Baptist Church, 128 North Chalkville Road, and at NorthPark Baptist Church, 5630 Deerfoot Parkway from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m., Central Daylight Time.

If necessary, a run-off election will be held on Tuesday, October 4, 2016.

Any qualified elector who will have resided within the municipality for a period of at least ninety (90) days on election day may qualify to run for office by filing the appropriate forms and paying any appropriate fees, as otherwise provided by law.

The Municipal Elections Manager (City Clerk) will begin accepting Statements of Candidacy at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 7, 2020. No Statement of Candidacy for this election will be accepted later than Tuesday, July 21, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.
