

STAGE AND VENUE MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT AND LICENSE

This Venue Management Services Agreement and License ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the City of Trussville, Alabama, a municipal corporation duly organized and existing in the State of Alabama ("City"), and Ferus LLC, an Alabama limited liability company ("Ferus").

WHEREAS, the City of Trussville is the owner of a new stage and outdoor event area ("Venue") located in the heart of downtown Trussville in an area known as "Quad 1." This Venue area has been constructed as a part of a revitalization project; and

WHEREAS, a significant public investment in the Quad 1 area and the stage has been spent in order to generate local and regional opportunities and to draw tourists and local residents to enjoy various cultural events; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trussville has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens that the City utilizes the services of a private company for the management, operation, and promotional services of the Venue, which services cannot reasonably be provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, Coby Lake ("Lake") is a principal of both Ferus and Downtown Trussville, LLC and has invested considerably in the infrastructure and enhancement of the downtown area and has agreed to provide venue management services, including operations and marketing services for the Venue; and

WHEREAS, Lake has experience booking and managing (i.e. providing "Event Services") the type of concerts and events for which the Venue is intended; and

WHEREAS, in a typical services agreement, such event service providers are compensated by the municipalities they serve; however, Ferus would provide such services free of charge in exchange for the rights established herein and in the Promotions Agreement (defined below); and

WHEREAS, this Agreement sets out the terms and conditions by which the City agrees to engage Ferus to provide high quality Event Services for the Venue for certain concerts and other live events and grants a license to Ferus to use the Venue as permitted herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing mutual promises, covenants, and agreements contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. Use of City Property / Ownership of Assets

(A) Venue. The Venue is a stage and an outdoor event complex located in the section known as "Quad 1" in downtown Trussville, Alabama. The complex is comprised of a stage, backstage area, dressing rooms, a seating area, and restrooms, collectively known as "the Venue" as further described and identified on Exhibit A.

(B) Inventory of Other Assets and Responsibility for Use.

(1) An inventory of the City's furniture, fixtures, and equipment ("Other Assets") made available for use by Ferus in providing Event Services at the Venue is attached hereto as Exhibit B. This inventory is to be created and maintained by the City and is subject to amendments as any additional Other Assets are acquired and made available for use.

(2) Said Inventory is to include an itemized list of all Other Assets made available to Ferus and will be periodically inspected or reviewed by the City at the City's sole discretion. Ferus accepts the use of the Venue and the Other Assets "as is" and has had an opportunity to inspect the Venue and note the condition.

(3) In consideration for these Other Assets being made available for Ferus's use, Ferus accepts responsibility for the cost of repair or replacement for any Other Assets that are damaged, stolen, or lost in the course of or as a result of Ferus's use, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

(C) Use of City Other Assets.

(1) The City grants permission and licenses Ferus to enter upon and use the Venue and Other Assets described and included in Exhibits A and B for the purposes of providing Event Services. Ferus is permitted to use and exercise control over such Other Assets as needed for the providing of such services, as is further stated herein.

(2) Any permissive Event Services use of the City's Other Assets by Ferus must be logged and recorded in a manner determined by Ferus. Except as provided under the terms of this Agreement and the separate license agreement between the City and Ferus dated September 23, 2020 (the License Agreement"), no other use of the Venue by Ferus is permitted without the express written consent of the Mayor or his designee. This Agreement is not intended to affect the terms of the License Agreement.

(D) Ownership Retained. At all times the City remains the owner of the Venue and Other Assets contained thereon and the real property upon which the Venue is situated. No real property interest or ownership is conveyed to Ferus under this Agreement as this is a contract for services.

(E) Right of Entry / Notice.

(1) The City and its employees shall have the absolute and unconditional right to enter all portions of the Venue at any time with or without notice to conduct inspections and observe the performance of Ferus in its obligations under this Agreement; to install, remove, adjust, repair, replace and/or handle the Venue, the Other Assets, and to inspect any or all portions of the Venue to maintain any and all utilities in or about the Venue.

(2) Nothing in this Section is intended or construed to limit any other rights of the City under this Agreement, nor shall impose or be construed to impose upon the City independent liability for failure to make any repairs, replacements, alterations, additions and/or improvements to the Venue.

II. Administration

(A) Professional Management Services. Ferus shall be responsible to ensure the proper operation of the Venue in connection with its Event Services. Ferus agrees to make best efforts to minimize the City's involvement in Event Services, but the City maintains the right, in its absolute and sole discretion, to approve all events and surrounding operations subject to the terms of this Agreement. Ferus shall ensure all use of the Venue and Other Assets complies with all applicable federal, state, and local laws.

(B) Administration. Ferus agrees to prepare and coordinate with the City a master calendar of all Venue / Stage events, bookings, and Venue operations (the "Event Calendar"). The Event Calendar will incorporate and manage all events at the Venue, including without limitation annual and other City events. Ferus will control and be responsible for management and implementation of the Event Calendar for the Venue.

(1) Ticketed Events. "Ticketed Events" are events that will require a presale of tickets for general admission to see a particular act while non-ticket holders are excluded from entry. If the event is not ticketed, it shall be designated as a "Non-Ticketed Event." Ferus and the City acknowledge that concerts and events for which tickets will be sold and required for entry ("Ticketed Events") will be granted priority on the Event Calendar.

(2) City Events. "City Events" are those events that are scheduled specifically by the City. The City may schedule any event at the Venue provided that Ferus is given at least thirty (30) calendar days' advance notice of the proposed date, or less if the Parties agree, and that no other event is already scheduled on the Event Calendar on the proposed date. The City will be responsible for any cost that may be associated with a City Event.

(3) Ferus Events. For purposes of this Agreement, any event for which Ferus exercises its right to provide Event Services shall be referred to as a "Ferus Event." Ferus's rights and obligation in relation to these Ferus Events are as follows:

(a) Ferus will be responsible for providing Event Services for no fewer than twenty (20) Ticketed Events over one (1) year beginning from the Effective Date of this Agreement.

(b) Ferus will be responsible for providing all services and security at Ferus Events the cost of which is to be paid by Ferus or its designee. If the event is a City Event, the City will reimburse Ferus for actual costs related to the event. Ferus will not seek reimbursement for labor costs of its full-time employees except as specifically provided herein (e.g. the sound and light manager).

(c) Ferus will determine all aspects of the Venue setup in conjunction with Event Services for Ferus Events. Ferus agrees to provide a proposed general plan for Ferus Events addressing security, sound levels, and desired City support which will be submitted for compliance with pre-established parameters developed by Ferus in conjunction with the City. The plan must include City coordination and any additional approvals which may be necessary.

(4) Third-Party Events. "Third-Party Events" are those events not proposed by Ferus or the City. Any request for a Third-Party Event shall be submitted to Ferus, as the Venue Management Company, who may place the Third-Party Event on the Event Calendar. Ferus shall be responsible for overseeing the use of the Venue and Other Assets in compliance with this Agreement as well as all federal, state, and local law. Any costs associated with the Third-Party Event shall be negotiated between Ferus and the Third-Party. Subject to the City's approval, Ferus may create any rules regarding the use of the Venue and Other Assets by a Third-Party that complies with the terms of this Agreement.

(5) Events Generally. The parties agree that, for all concerts and events at the Venue:

- (a) Each event must be coordinated with Ferus on the Event Calendar;
- (b) No outside food or drink will be allowed without Ferus's express written permission or if Ferus is unable to provide;
- (c) Ferus will designate the individual or entity to control the light and sound equipment;
- (d) To the extent City approval is required related to such events, the Mayor has authority to make approval on behalf of the City; and
- (e) The City will acquire all music and entertainment licensing rights, including but not limited to public performance rights like ASCAP and BMI, except that if separate additional licensing rights are required for Ferus Events, Ferus is responsible for acquiring those rights.

(C) Promotions Agreement. Ferus will have the right to contract with an experienced concert promoter to assist Ferus in providing Event Services for Ferus Events ("Promotions Agreement"). Any such Promotions Agreement between Ferus and the promoter shall require approval of the City, said approval not unreasonably withheld. By way of example, the Promotions Agreement will include, without limitation, costs for talent, advertising, security, and similar necessary Events Services for which Ferus (and not the City) will be responsible unless stated otherwise herein.

III. Venue Operations

(A) Ferus agrees to coordinate with the City for the Venue usage. Ferus will develop a standard Operating Procedures manual for the Venue operation during Ferus Events and will work with the City to develop and modify the standard Operating Procedure manual, draft all agreements and contracts, establish insurance requirements, and draft necessary forms for related Event Services. Ferus agrees to assemble and maintain a list of service providers which may be contracted by Ferus to provide necessary services. Ferus will be solely responsible for negotiating and contracting for such services which may include, but are not limited to the following:

- (1) Sound system;
- (2) Lighting;

- (3) Tickets;
- (4) Box office operations;
- (5) VIP services;
- (6) Pre-show VIP events;
- (7) Talent;
- (8) Support for spaces (dressing rooms, green rooms, etc.);
- (9) Security;
- (10) Crowd control;
- (11) Event staff and ushers;
- (12) Food and beverage vendors;
- (13) Merchandise vendors;
- (14) Setting up / taking down;
- (15) Site control (access and conduct of guests, barriers, gates, points of entry);
- (16) Sound level control and monitoring;
- (17) Portable sanitation;
- (18) Clean-up on-site and affected neighboring areas;
- (19) Trash and recycle on-site and affected neighboring areas; and
- (20) Perform an after-event review of City improvements to check for any damages.

The City reserves the right to assign any other task to Ferus that may be reasonably related to the operation of the venue. Such assignment of task shall be done in writing provided to Ferus as soon as is apparent for the need of the additional task.

(B) City Services. Ferus will work with the City to plan and coordinate for services to be provided by the City, which may include, without limitation, the following:

- (1) Police;
- (2) Fire;
- (3) EMS;
- (4) First-aid;
- (5) Traffic control
- (6) Permits;
- (7) Licenses;
- (8) Noise exemption;
- (9) Sound level control monitoring;
- (10) Community services.

(C) Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the City will have final decision making authority with regard to the approval of all entertainment to be booked at the Venue.

(D) Use of Venue by Third-Party. Any third-party using the Venue and Other Assets must comply with any restrictions and use only vendors and operators approved by Ferus.

(E) Management Fees. Based upon the Covid-19 Pandemic and the uncertainty surrounding the booking of talent and other events, for the first year, Ferus shall not be requested to pay the City for the use of the venue for up to twenty (20) Ferus Events during the first calendar year.

Each event shall be scheduled not less than thirty (30) calendar days prior to the occurrence of the event, unless the Mayor provides permission for a shorter time.

IV. Default

(A) Termination for Cause. The City may terminate this Agreement upon the occurrence of an event of default caused by any actions / inactions of Ferus, including, but not limited to, the following:

(1) Ferus fails in any material respect to comply with any material contractual terms, covenants, agreements, and/or conditions of this Agreement and such failure continues without cure for more than thirty (30) calendar days after written notice, constituting a default;

(2) Admission in writing of Ferus's inability to pay its debts as they become due;

(3) Ferus's filing of a petition for bankruptcy or re-organization or arrangement under the Bankruptcy Code;

(4) Ferus makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors; and/or

(5) Ferus consents to the appointment of a Trustee Receiver for all or major part of its property or is adjudged bankrupt or insolvent under any federal or state law.

(B) The performance of the City of its obligations in this Agreement are subject to and contingent upon the availability of public funds lawfully expended for the purpose of this Agreement for the initial term and any future term.

V. General Provisions

(A) Insurance.

(1) Ferus shall during the entire term of this Agreement, at Ferus's own and sole expense, keep in force by advance payment of premiums, **general liability insurance** in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 for property damage and injury to or death as a result of one occurrence, \$2,000,000.00 general aggregate, including coverage for allegations of assault and battery, insuring Ferus, including the City as a named additional insured, and the City's servants and employees as additional insureds, against any liability that may accrue against them individually or any of them on account of any occurrences in or about the Venue whether or not the insureds may be at fault. Any policy shall specifically provide **liquor liability coverage** in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 including coverage for allegations of assault and battery, \$1,000,000.00 general aggregate, insuring Ferus, including the City as a named additional insured, and the City's servants and employees as additional insureds, against any liability that may accrue against them individually or any of them on account of any occurrences in or about the Venue whether or not the insureds may be at fault. Each policy shall waive the right of subrogation against the City, its Mayor, officers, council, employees, agents, attorneys and/or representatives. This insurance for the additional insured(s) shall be as broad as the coverage provided for the named insured. This

insurance for the additional insured(s) shall apply as Primary Insurance before any other insurance or self-insurance, including any deductible, maintained by, or provided to, the additional insured.

(2) Ferus shall during the entire term of this Agreement, at Ferus's own and sole expense, keep in force by advance payment of premiums, **property insurance including mobile equipment**, insuring the City's furniture, fixtures, and equipment described in Exhibit B and including additional Other Assets when acquired, said coverage to specifically include theft of property, in an amount of not less than \$500,000.00, for the benefit of the City. Said policy shall waive the right of subrogation against the City, its Mayor, officers, council, employees, agents, attorneys and/or representatives and include the city as an additional insured & loss payee.

(3) Ferus shall during the entire term of this Agreement, at Ferus's own and sole expense, keep in force by advance payment of premiums, **auto liability** in an amount of \$1,000,000.00, **non-owned auto liability** in an amount of \$1,000,000.00 and **hired auto liability** in an amount of \$1,000,000.00, insuring Ferus, including the City as a named additional insured, and the City's servants and employees as additional insureds, against any liability that may accrue against them individually or any of them on account of any occurrences in or about the Venue whether or not the insureds may be at fault. Said policy shall waive the right of subrogation against the City, its Mayor, officers, council, employees, agents, attorneys and/or representatives. This insurance for the additional insured(s) shall be as broad as the coverage provided for the named insured. This insurance for the additional insured(s) shall apply as Primary Insurance before any other insurance or self-insurance, including any deductible, maintained by, or provided to, the additional insured.

(4) Ferus shall during the entire term of this Agreement, at Ferus's own and sole expense, keep in force by advance payment of premiums, an **umbrella policy** in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 for property damage and injury to or death and including the non-owned auto exposure, insuring Ferus.

(5) Ferus shall furnish to the City certificates of all insurance required herein. Said certificates shall name the City as an additional insured and indicate additional insured status of the City servants and employees on each of the required policies. Proof of Ferus adding the City as an additional insured, and the servants and employees, shall be provided within fourteen (14) calendar days of the Mayor executing this Agreement. Failure to provide this proof, or at any time in the future shall the City not be named as an additional insured, or coverage to the City servants or employees is precluded, or the insurance required herein shall lapse, the City may terminate this Agreement due to Ferus's material breach.

(B) Assignment. Ferus shall be prohibited from assigning, transferring, conveying, and/or subletting any part of this Agreement to any other person and/or entity without the prior written consent by the City the said approval of any such assignment shall be in the sole discretion of the City.

(C) Independent Contractor. Ferus is an independent contractor as set forth herein. Neither Ferus or any of Ferus's officers, employees, agents, or servants shall hold themselves out or claim to be officers, employees, or representatives of the City. Ferus acknowledges and agrees that

nothing in this Agreement is intended or construed in any way to create or establish any partnership or joint venture between the City and Ferus.

(D) Defense / Indemnification / Hold Harmless. Ferus hereby agrees and covenants to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless to the fullest extent permitted by law the City of Trussville, Alabama, its Mayor, officers, council, employees, agents, attorneys and/or representatives arising out of and in connection with this Agreement from and against any loss or expense which may arise by reason of liability for damage, injury, and/or death or invasion of personal property or property rights directly caused by the negligent or wrongful act on the part of Ferus, including, but not limited to: (i) claims for property damage; (ii) claims for personal injury; (iii) claims of personal injury to third-parties; and (iv) reasonable attorney fees.

(E) Representations / Warranties.

(1) The City represents and warrants to Ferus all required approvals have been obtained in the County, and the City has full legal right, power, and authority to enter into and perform its obligations hereunder.

(2) This Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by the City and constitutes a valid and binding obligation of the City only upon approval by the City Council, execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, and execution by Ferus's authorized representative.

(3) Ferus represents and warrants to the City all required approvals have been or will be obtained, and Ferus has the full legal right, power, and authority to enter into and perform its obligations hereunder.

(4) This Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by Ferus and constitutes a valid and binding obligation of Ferus.

(F) Notices. All notices, correspondence, documents, records, reports, etc. required under this Agreement shall be in writing and sent via United States Certified Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested; overnight by courier; or by hand-delivery. All notices required under this Agreement shall be given to the Parties at the addresses indicated below, or at other places the Parties may designate in writing:

(G) Non-Waiver. Failure by the City to enforce upon or insist upon compliance with any terms or conditions of this Agreement or failure to give notice or declare the Agreement terminated shall not constitute a general waiver of the relinquishment of same or any other terms, conditions, or acts, but the same shall be and remain at all times in full force and effect.

(H) Modification This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the Parties. Any modification of this Agreement shall be in writing.

(I) Mediation/ Dispute Resolution.

(1) All controversies, claims, disputes, and matters in question arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the breach thereof, shall be decided first by good-faith negotiations between the Parties. The party who seeks resolution of a controversy, claim, dispute or other matter in question shall notify the other party in writing of the existence and subject matter(s) that are in dispute.

(2) If the good faith negotiation is not successful, the Parties shall then mediate the dispute(s). The mediator shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties. If the Parties cannot agree as to the mediator, then each Party's respective mediator shall select another mediator. The recipient party shall select from such list one individual to act as a mediator in the dispute set forth by the notifying party. The parties agree to meet with said mediator in Jefferson County, Alabama within two (2) weeks after the recipient party has received notice of the dispute and agree to utilize their best efforts and all expediency to resolve the matters in dispute. The mediation shall not continue longer than one (1) hearing day without the written approval of both parties. Neither party shall be bound by any recommendation of the mediator; however, any agreement reached during mediation shall be final and conclusive. The expense of the mediation shall be shared equally by both Parties.

(3) If the dispute is not resolved by such mediation, then a complaint may be filed in the Birmingham Division of the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, Alabama. Such complaint shall be tried before a judge only. Each party hereby acknowledges and waives its right to a trial by jury on all claims and damages.

(J) Drafting Party. The provisions of this Agreement and the documents referred to herein have been examined, negotiated, drafted, and revised by counsel for each party to this Agreement. Therefore, no implication shall be drawn or made against any party by virtue of the drafting of this Agreement.

(K) Compliance with Anti-Discrimination Legislation. When providing or contracting to provide services, programs, or activities to maintain the facilities, or perform obligations under this Agreement, Ferus shall comply with the Americans with Disability Act; the Civil Rights Act; and any other federal or state law which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, marital status, or disability.

(L) Headings. The headings in this Agreement are for convenience only, confirm no rights or obligations on either party, and do not alter any terms of this Agreement.

(M) Severability. If any term of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, then this Agreement, including all remaining terms shall remain in full force and effect.

(N) Effective Date / Termination. This Agreement shall be effective commencing on the _____ day of _____, 202____, and shall continue for one (1) year until the _____ day of _____, 202____. After the initial term, the Agreement may be extended for additional terms provided the same is agreed to by the Parties in writing.

WHEREAS, the Parties have set their hand and seal on the effective on the date the last Party executes this Agreement.
